While the list above states items that they are in urgent need of they will also accept any tinned and dry packet items for redistribution. They will not accept any fresh food

We will be collecting donations all of this week and up until Monday 30th September. In assembly, we will be celebrating the donations as a whole school before they are collected and distributed to families via the foodbank.
